

MOTORCYCLE IMPORT REGULATIONS

Please note that you must be in possession of the following **before** loading the container:

- Letter of Authority from the South African Bureau of Standards –
- Import Permit issued by the Department of Trade & Industry in Pretoria, South Africa

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR IMPORT AND LOA FOR A MOTORCYCLE.

3 Valuations of the motorcycle (obtained overseas) if the motorcycle is older than four years, OR the original purchase invoice if the vehicle is under four years old;

- Customs will only accept the highest valuation (this amount plus 10% to compensate for exchange rate fluctuation is to appear on the Import Permit);

Colour copy of registration, if not in your name, a proof of purchase is required.

Colour copy of photo page of clients ZA passport port. If a foreign passport we need copy and Photo page and permanent residence sticker page. Or copy of a ZA Identity document.

Costs that can be expected:

- Sch 1 Part 2B Duty & VAT at maximum 30% of the highest valuation. There is no duty if the client is first time immigrant with permanent residence. South African citizens that legally emigratd can apply to Customs Head Office in Pretoria for special permission to import a motorcycle duty free at the following address:
